We didn't expect Epiphany to "solve" our children's' challenges, but we watched our daughter go from barely able to make it through the school day without a meltdown to graduating; our son move from frequent internal retreats avoiding the stress of school, to now being the first one ready to head out the door, and with a smile on his face! Our other son finally found a place that allowed him to feel like he was with other people who just "got it." Without a doubt, the impact of this school is life changing for each of them.

We each have to find our own path in life, and we often wonder if we're making the right choices for our children. I know with 100% certainty is school has changed their lives for the better. Who knows what the future might hold, but they will be far better equipped to meet it for having been students at The Epiphany School.
